WHERE IS MY PROPERTY LINE?

City staff is frequently asked how to find property lines. Below is a helpful resource that provides detailed information on this topic. Some common questions they answer include:

- Is the city or county responsible for providing or finding survey markers at the corners of my lot? The property owner is responsible. It is not a service provided by the city.
- How do I locate the surveyor? MSPS Firm Member referral service.
- My neighbor has had their property surveyed. I don't think the property line is in the right place. What can I do? First, try to talk with the surveyor who did the work.
- My property has just been surveyed. The neighbors' fence is partly on my property. What should I do? You can ask your attorney about the possibility of creating an easement or license.
